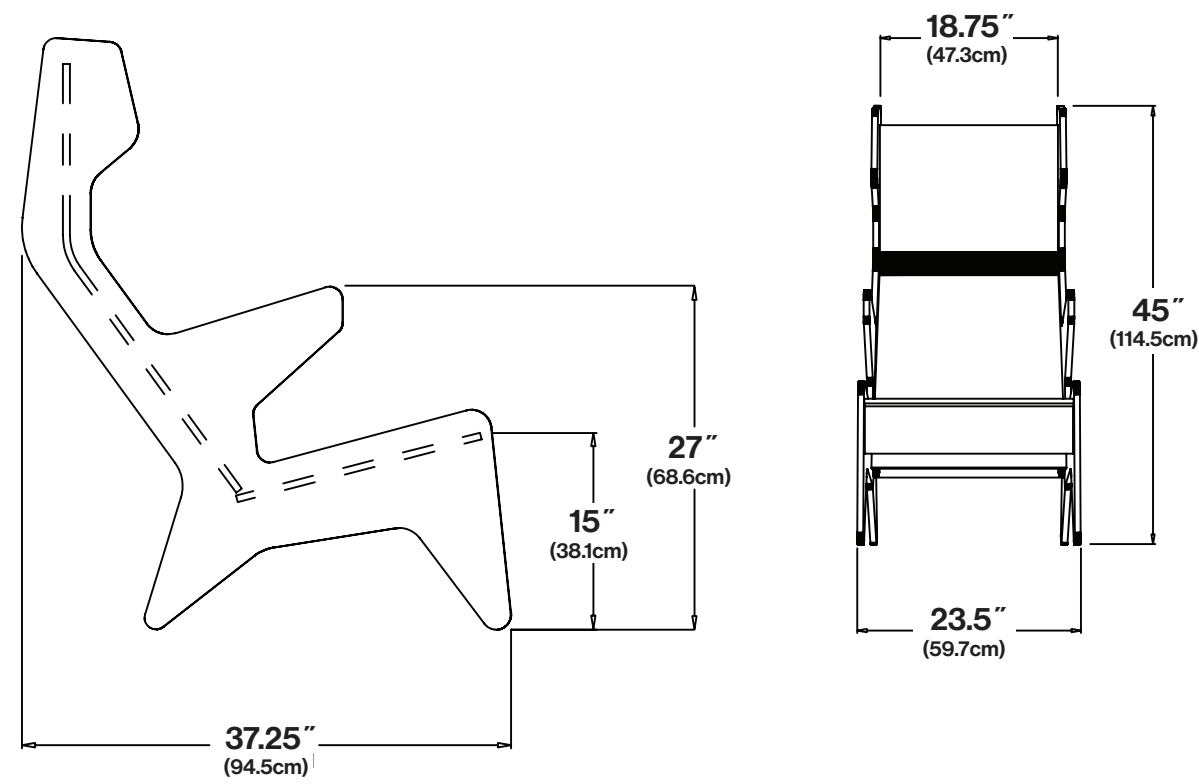

Ralph Rapson was a key figure in American Modernist architecture and design. He studied at the University of Michigan and later at Cranbrook Academy of Art under Eliel Saarinen. At 31, he gained acclaim for his "Greenbelt House" in the Case Study program. Known for his drawing skills, Rapson created hundreds of furniture designs, including a successful line for Knoll in the 1940s. Loll discovered his work through his son Toby, and together they brought many of Ralph's designs to life for the first time – crafted in recycled plastic under license from Rapson Inc®.
